Hamdan Sports Complex

The Hamdan Sports Complex is a multi-purpose sports arena in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. The arena was completed in summer 2010. It hosted the 2010 FINA World Swimming Championships, in which 153 countries. It also hosted the final games of the 2014 FIBA Under-17 World Championship and the 2015 FIVB Volleyball Men's U23 World Championship, and Asian fencing championship 2016.

The stadium will host international aquatic events. It has total capacity of 15,000 spectators. Beside aquatic events, such as swimming, it will also accommodate badminton, basketball, karate, swimming, tennis, volleyball, water polo.

For the world championships cadets and juniors Dubai 2022 will be installing 24 pistes for the preliminary 8 color pistes, podium for final and 16 pistes for training Hamdan Sports Complex is open is open to participants from March 30 to April 10 from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Accreditation

- According to the FIE outline of risk mitigation requirements “the accreditation will be provided to those participants who received a negative test result in the Host Country **and who have submitted the signed Acknowledgement of risk and release from Liability (appendix B) and the Covid-19 screening questionnaire for an FIE event (appendix C)**”. Appendix B and C will be collected in the following way:
- The accreditation office and system will remain operational until the end of the World Championships in “Hamdan Sports Complex”
- Accreditation will start 3 days before the competition. Working hours are daily from 08:00-18:00 from March 30 till April 10, 2021.
- Without accreditation no participant will be allowed to use internal transport, weapon control, training, venue, competition hall or any other facility.

- Accreditation cards with code will be prepared at the competition venue.
- Each participant will have to go to the venue to personally withdraw their accreditation, after:
 - Having filled in appendix B and C
 - having received a negative result and the corresponding bracelet to facilitate visual control
 - None will be allowed to take transportation to the venue without the bracelet attesting a negative test result.
- Parents accompanying children will not register on the FIE website. They will be accredited directly with the organizers outside/ in addition to the quota for each delegation.
- A personal photo of the accompany persons or parents of the athletes should be sent via email by maximum March, 15th 2021 for accreditation to accreditation@dubaiwfc.com
- Entry fees
The entry fees are; 55 Euros for the individual event and 140 Euros for the team event. Fees must be paid when registering in cash or by credit card when picking up accreditations

Embassy / Consulate. If you need any visa support or assistance, please fill in attached form and send it to the visa department along A copy of their passports and a passport (6 months' validity) sized photo addition to a modern portrait (The national identity of some countries) no later than 20th of Feb 2022 to receive the needed support by UAE Fencing Federation. Visa fee will be only **40 EUR per person**. It is extremely important that all requests are received by the stated date to ensure that the required visas are obtained on time. VIII Minor Athlete

Minor Athlete Travel:

The following are requirements regarding athletes under age 18 who are participating in 2022 Junior and Cadet World Championships.

Accompanied by Adult Only:

Minors are allowed to travel alone and enter the country without any problem. Just carry a letter from the National Federation to which he is affiliated, that he is participating in the tournament and will not face any problem at the airports. If a child under the age of 18 is traveling with someone who is not a parent or a legal guardian, the supervising adult must have a written and signed statement certifying that she/he has parental consent for the child.

Please fill in and sign the FIE Minor Athlete Travel form+ Passport copies of parents/legal guardian.

Accompanied by a Group:

In case of travelling with a group; the group should have a letter on organizational letterhead with:

- The name of the group and supervising adult(s).
- The names of the children on the trip and their primary address, phone number, date and place of birth, and name of at least one parent or legal guardian for each child.
- A written and signed statement of the supervising adult certifying that she/he has parental consent for each child.
- All minor should be accompanied by fully authorized person (team manager, coach, parent etc,... with the proper written authorization (cf. Minor sample authorization form on the FIE website: <https://fie.org/fie/documents/administrative-department>) to sign Appendixes B & C and to be PCR tested.

IX Dubai International airport

Dubai International Airport is a major international airport located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. Dubai International is situated in the Al Garhoud district. It is the world's busiest airport by international passenger traffic and it is the 3rd busiest airport in the world by passenger traffic, 70.5 million passengers. Over 140 airlines operate out of the airport to over 270 destinations across all six inhabited continents.



When the delegations arrive in Dubai, there is a tournament banner and an information desk, and all delegations are welcomed.

Transportation

Transportation from Airport to Hotel and vice versa is for 1 or 2 passenger **45 Euros for one way** and for more 3 passenger **35 Euros for one way**. Transport will be organized with the allocated busses that are during the WCH going to be used only for transport of the participants. Each team will have allocated bus. Small teams will use minibuses. All the vehicles will be used at 50% of their capacities in order to ensure sanitary distance. All the drivers are going to be PCR tested the same applies for all the OC members, volunteers, security etc.

Covid-19 Precautionary Plan

Junior & Cadet World Championship Dubai 2022 – Covid-19 control protocol and Crisis Management plan.

General principles, airport, hotel

1. The instructions, and procedures issued in the General Principles for the Reopening of Services and Entertainments Facilities during the Coexistence Period with COVID19 shall be followed <https://www.dha.gov.ae/en/Covid19/Pages/Coronavirus.aspx>
2. All organizers, staff or workers, has to do test and ensure all teams, employees, workers during the competition are covid-19 free.
3. Test will be done free of charge in Dubai Airport upon arrival aer the passport control for all Guests including (players, coaches, technical and administrative members, assistants).
4. All participants should stay at their accommodation until they receive negative results by message (SMS) or by ALHOSN App.
5. People who will receive negative results will be asked to go for receiving there bracelet in the hotel.
6. ALHOSN App will ask for the Unified ID which can be found on your entry stamp or last page of your passport and you can ask the immigration desk at the Airport.
7. We recommend all participants to install ALHOSN App and print your results <https://www.alhosnapp.ae/en/home>
8. Participants who got covid-19 vaccine are not excluded from test.
9. they are not in competition time.
4. All participants should maintain healthy behavior such as washing hands regularly.
5. Health control team will be observing and managing the prevention procedures during the event.
6. Referees must wear a face shield/visor in addition to facemask, when performing a weapon test either before or during a bout. No relevant rule.
7. In case of injury only doctor as well as medical staff of the competition and their team members can approach the injured fencer and they must wear facemasks, gloves and a face shield/visor.
8. Facemasks: Fencers are exempted from wearing a face mask during the rest periods. During rest periods, all people in the fencing piste area will have to maintain a distance of 1.5 meter from the fencer(s). Coaches are allowed to stay at 1 meter from the fencer but will have to wear a face shield/visor in addition to the facemask.
9. During the stay (every 4 days after arrival day) one rapid test will be conducted for all participants. (The rapid test used will be WHO approved). Result expected in max 15 minutes.
10. Only who receive a negative result of the rapid test will be allowed to enter training and competition
11. After each test people will receive a bracelet to facilitate the visual control.

Preventative procedures during the competition

1. face mask and hand sanitizing is a must.
2. All facilities will sterilize before opening every day and during the event days.
3. All players must keep face mask as long as

Covid-19 positive / suspected cases protocol

- In the event that a confirmed case of Covid-19 is discovered in one or more players, or the technical or administrative staff, or the service staff, the following procedures are followed:
- the local health authorities are informed directly.
- the case / cases are isolated according to the instructions of the concerned local health authority.
- Players, technical and administrative staff, service staff, and everyone who has a direct relationship with the team are examined before returning to the activity.
- In the event that a case of infection with the Covid-19 virus is recorded, the infected and those in contact must abide by medical instructions, retest PCR, if their results negative, they can continue competing without quarantine.
- the health status is evaluated by the concerned local health authorities, which is the authority that decides the subsequent procedures, and everyone should adhere to the procedures it issues
- The Isolation process will take place in a prepared Isolation rooms in the hotel Or an Isolation room in the stadium with separated exit excess and away from the playing hall and medical center.

Covid-19 positive/ suspected cases protocol

- Any suspected case with clear symptoms will be Isolated till be tested for COVID-19 with a PCR test before returning back to the event.
- Who will receive a negative test result will be able to rejoin the playing/ training hall.

To ensure success and safety of the Competition, we have to work together as a team against the spread of covid-19. We should avoid gatherings during the process of the competition and limit outdoor activities/entertainment such as shopping as much as possible.

Return test

1. PCR Test will be provided either in separated and Isolated room in the stadium or in the main hotel – free of charge –
2. The PCR screening will be available during all days of the competition.
3. All Head of delegates should inform the competition organizing committee about the returning dates and the PCR duration before travel accepted by the country.
4. If the country needs any other special requirements & documents the fencing federation of the country should send it by e-mail to the competition organizing committee before the competition by 14 working days.
